D2a. Workers Compensation: Settlement Future Medical Claims Project Update

D2b. Volunteer Coverage

D2b1. Volunteer Coverage through Workers Compensation

Conor Boughey reported that historically MBASIA reported that volunteers were not covered by MBASIA's Workers Compensation Program, however Safety Volunteers (e.g. volunteer fire officers) are covered by the Workers Compensation program. While reviewing the Memorandum of Coverage, the language allows a Member agency to pass a resolution to cover volunteers, but no members has and MBASIA has not approved any volunteer coverage. No revisions would be necessary to allow coverage to volunteers.

Conor informed the Board that Entities sometimes pass a Council Resolution that provides coverage for specific, or certain groups of volunteers (interns, certain program volunteers, explorers, etc.). The resolution attached in the agenda packet is just a sample for information purposes. It is very uncommon for an entity to provide workers compensation coverage to ALL volunteers, this would be more commonly addressed through AD&D coverage.

No reportable action took place.

D2b2. AD&D Policy

Conor Boughey presented the AD&D quote from the Alliant Volunteer Insurance Program (VIP) as requested by the Board at the January 2018 Board Meeting to be effective 7/1/2018.

A motion was made to bind Option 2 of the AD&D quote subject to changing the number of volunteers to 1,253 from 1,252 because the City of Greenfield added one intern to the volunteer count.

D2c. CARMA Insurance Renewal

Conor Boughey presented CARMA's budget. There is a 7.4% premium decrease from last year's premium. However, payroll increased by 5.7% and the ex-mod is still above average. The primary driver of the reduction was MBASIA's request to reconsider how CARMA allocates the admin expense. Because MBASIA is a member of CARMA and we did not provide notice to terminate, the renewal will be automatic.

D2d. ERMA Insurance Renewal

Conor Boughey presented ERMA's budget. There is a 15% premium increase from last year's premium due to an increase in payroll of 5.7% and the ex-mod has increased to 102.5%. Another reason for this increase is that ERMA's budget includes a new layer of insurance. Previously ERMA provided coverage from MBASIA's retention to \$2,000,000, but this year the ERMA Board is considering increasing this limit to \$3,000,000. Because MBASIA is a member of ERMA and we did not provide notice to terminate, the renewal will be automatic.

D2e. Excess Workers' Compensation Renewal

Conor Boughey reported that Excess Workers' Compensation (EWC) premium has decreased about 2% despite an increase in payroll. The rate has come down a fair amount and in general, EWC rates have been pretty flat all around. Historically, EWC rates have increased by about 11% each year but now the rates are more stable, which is positive news.

Conor Boughey reported that one major change this year is that King City is now part of the MBASIA APIP placement. Conor also walked through key coverage changes that were listed in the APIP program such as: Unscheduled Infrastructure Sublimit reduced from \$2,000,000 to \$750,000; Multiple enhancements to Cyber Liability coverage, including Business Interruption for System Failures, Cyber Funds Transfer Fraud and other increased sublimits; and Pollution Coverage updates and increased sublimits, including Sewer Backup with \$250,000 sublimit, and increased sublimits for indoor/mold sublimits.

The Program Administrators will send to the individual members who participate in APIP the Claims Reporting Forms for Property, Cyber, Pollution and the APIP Claims Reporting Acknowledgement Receipt form. The APIP Claims Reporting Acknowledgement Receipt form needs to be signed by the member, scanned and emailed back to Alliant.

D3. NEW BUSINESS

D3a. MBASIA's Workers Compensation Underlying Policy

Conor Boughey reported that MBASIA maintains a Memorandum of Coverage (MOC) for the Workers Compensation pooled program. This MOC applies to coverage between the Member's retention, and MBASIA's attachment to excess coverage.

Workers Compensation coverage is much more controlled by code and statute, and coverage forms do not vary drastically. Because of this, many pools that obtain excess coverage from CSAC EIA, or LAWCX, issue an "Underlyer" which is a policy document that references the excess coverage form as the controlling form for the underlying layer of coverage. By doing this, the MOC is automatically updated to match the excess form. This removes any chance of a gap in coverage forming over time.

A motion was made to discard the current MOC and approve the Underlying MOC as presented.
