The Board of Directors discussed the status of the City of King's compliance with the Performance Improvement Plan (PIP) that the City had agreed to. Members considered the City to be in breach of the PIP and discussed several options for moving forward, including raising the City's Self Insured Retention (SIR), or beginning the process of an involuntary termination.

Jamie Goldstein made a motion to implement a \$100,000 retention effective immediately for the City of King, to agendize and notice termination at a future Board meeting, to seek information from the City of King as to what a graceful exit would look like, and to have staff report on the implications of involuntary termination.

Adela Gonzales requested that Jamie amend his motion to include a \$250,000 retention for police related activities and \$50,000 for all other liability claims.
